UCI Police Department is investigating an indecent exposure incident that occurred at approximately 5:04 p.m. on Saturday, April 2, on the third floor of the Student Center Parking Structure.

A female victim reported that while she was inside her vehicle, a male subject parked his vehicle in an adjacent parking stall and approached the driver's side window of her vehicle. He then exposed himself to her and immediately drove away in an unknown direction. A similar incident occurred in the afternoon on Saturday, March 26, at the Vista Del Campo Community Center pool.

The suspect in this case is described as an Asian male, approximately 5'09" to 5'10", late twenties to early thirties, black hair, no facial hair, wearing a white hat, blue and white striped shirt and unknown colored pants. He was seen driving a red four door Toyota Corolla. No further description.
