UCIPD is investigating two residential burglaries that occurred in Vista del Campo Norte Student Housing. The first burglary occurred between 12/20/18 - 12/26/18 the time is unknown. The suspect cut and removed the window screen to gain entry into the apartment.

The second burglary occurred between 12/26/18 - 12/27/18 (2 p.m. and 1:15 a.m.). The suspect cut and removed the screen to gain entry into the apartment. The apartment was ransacked.
