UCIPD is investigating a residential burglary that occurred at Vista Del Campo (VDC) Student Housing. Saturday evening, around 10:30 pm, a resident woke up to someone breaking into the bedroom. The screen to the window had been removed and the window was opened. Upon seeing the resident, the suspect fled the scene. It is believed that this burglary is linked to two similar incidents that occurred in VDC in August.

Safety Tips:

- Immediatley report all suspicious activities to the UCI Police Department at (949)824-5223.
