Attempted Burglary

On December 29, 2022, at about 8:15 p.m., UCIPD Campus Safety Ambassadors (CSAs) conducted a vacation check for a resident in the University Hills community (Murasaki St.) and noticed the rear sliding screen door had been removed from the patio sliding door. Upon further investigation, UCIPD CSA's also noticed a pry mark on a nearby living room window screen, which was not removed. All other doors and windows were found to be intact and it did not appear entry was made into the home. The attempted burglary occurred sometime between December 28, 2022, at approximately 7:50 p.m. and December 29, 2022 at 8:15 p.m.
